

Vehicle Requirements for Road Test

Essential Items Rejection for noncompliance as required by TAC §15.54	
1.	Valid Vehicle Registration
2.	License Plates (Front and Rear when applicable)
3.	Auto Insurance (as required by TRC, Section 601.053)
4.	Brake Lights (both)
5.	Horn
6.	Mirrors (interior or exterior rearview)
7.	Turn Signals (front and rear)
8.	Doors (must open from inside and outside)
9.	Seat Belts
Conditional Items Rejection for noncompliance when conditions warrant	
1.	Windshield wipers
2.	Headlights
3.	Tail lights

Note:

Unsanitary Vehicles – vehicles that present unsanitary conditions, to the extent that is hazardous for the examiner, should not be used for the drive test. The applicant should be encouraged and allowed to remove or clean the hazard before proceeding with the drive test. Unsanitary conditions include bodily fluids, insects, food, etc. that interfere with the examiner's ability to be properly seated.
